TRANSPORATION

- Per Individual Supports Policy – Board approved on 9/17/15
 - The Board’s second priority is to fund transportation for employment activities
 - Expectation is that the individual will use the most cost effective form of transportation
 - The individual will need to contribute towards the cost of their transportation. The individual’s personal income will be taken in consideration before accessing County Board money. If the individual is not working/employed, the first step in the planning process is discussion about employment
 - For children under the age of 18, the family’s financial contribution will be based on the Family Directed Resources (FDR) policy.
- Waivers
 - Individuals who are enrolled on the waiver may choose to utilize their local match allocation of support services when
 - Service is not available by the waiver or
 - Cannot find a certified waiver provider who is available and willing
