When you schedule a home visit (at home, in the community, or virtually), you can talk about your concerns, ask questions, and receive reliable information about topics like:

- ✓ Pregnancy
- ✓ Baby and child health
- ✓ Breastfeeding
- ✓ Nutrition
- ✓ Immunizations
- ✓ Child growth and development
- ✓ Discipline
- ✓ Toilet training
- ✓ Child safety
- ✓ Household safety
- ✓ Local resources
